Interfaith Hospitality Network is now in our seventh year of hosting homeless families. During 2010 (see the IHN Annual Report) IHN served twice as many families as the previous year, and families stayed in the Network half as long.

An amazing 73% of our families in 2010 left the Network to move into homes of their own. In 2010, six families were able to move from the Network into one of IHN's four transitional housing apartments—two have since moved into perma-

nent housing.

In July 2010, IHN received Community Development Block grant funding to provide security and utility deposits and rental subsidies to help our families move from the Network into their own homes. I believe transitional housing and rent subsidies have played a significant role in getting families into housing more quickly, and thereby making it possible for IHN to help more families.

IRA Tax Break Back in 2011

Under the new tax law, if you are 70 ½ or older you can donate up to \$100,000 to a charitable organization(s) from your IRA, and the IRA withdrawal will not be considered part of your taxable income. Whether you itemize or don't, supporting charities whose work you value with an IRA withdrawal donation can reduce the taxes you would normally pay by either reducing your taxable income or keeping you in a lower tax bracket. At the age of 70 ½, IRA owners are required to make yearly withdrawals from their IRA accounts, and these withdrawal amounts are considered taxable income. Or you can direct your IRA custodian to write a check to Interfaith Hospitality Network, or another charity, and the amount withdrawn will not be subject to taxes. We urge you to check with your own financial advisor, as this may result in significant tax savings to some donors.

Interfaith Hospitality Network of Yellowstone County Annual Report for 2010

- 29 families
- 39 adults, 55 children, including 15 children age five and under
- Two-thirds of families headed by single parent (including one single father and one single grandmother)
- Average stay in Network was 47 days
- 4,250 people nights of shelter provided by network congregations
- Over 8,500 meals served to guest families
- 320 calls for service
- 73% of families moved into their own homes
- Helped families with security deposits and rental subsidies through CDBG grant to help them move into and stay in housing
- All four of IHN's transitional housing apartments occupied; two families successfully transitioned from transitional housing to permanent housing
- 21 participating congregations
- Over 1,800 volunteers
- More than 20,000 hours of volunteer service
